## **Training within Solihull**

The current position of Training within the County is that a large number of people have not completed the Getting Started Modules. Several of these have been in post for longer than the five months that the Association allow for completing the Modules and we recognise that we must address this with some urgency.

## **Learning Backlog**

To tackle this backlog we wish to make use of the Scout Association's E-Learning modules that are available at [www.scouts.org.uk/learnersresources](http://www.scouts.org.uk/learnersresources), as well as the expertise that is currently available within the County.

Please encourage the people listed, from your group or unit, to complete their Training. If you don't feel confident in explaining how to use it let us know and we can help.

Part of the E-Learning includes a quiz where it's possible to print off a certificate on completion of the Module. Please ask the Learners to produce these certificates as they will assist in Validation.

## **Validation**

Validation should be undertaken by someone who has already completed their Module 25 Training or by someone who is performing the Validation as part of their own Validation having completed the Module 25 Training.

Validation should be carried out in the simplest and most effective manner, usually at a section meeting with the learner in action. Please let us know if you need assistance with Validation.

There is a separate list of people who have completed training but need validation.

## **Timescales**

We want to complete this as soon as possible and our aim is to ensure that everybody, currently in the system, completes both the E-Learning and Validation by the end of March 2009. Please let us know if for any reason you cannot use this method. As this is a relatively short timescale and as we want to ensure that we have this firmly in hand we will be contacting you regularly to see how you are progressing.

**Ongoing training**

Once we have this side of Training firmly under control we can look forward to sorting out the remaining Modules. It has been arranged with Birmingham, Coventry and Hereford and Worcester Scout Counties to utilise their training opportunities.
